Teach children water safety and swimming skills as early as possible. Always brief babysitters on water safety, emphasizing the need for constant supervision. Appoint a designated watcher to monitor children during social gatherings at or near pools. Equip doors and windows that exit to a pool area with alarms.

A private swimming pool means any structure, located in a residential area, that is intended for swimming or recreational bathing and contains water over 24 inches deep, including, but not limited to, in-ground, aboveground, and on-ground swimming pools; hot tubs; and non-portable spas.

However, having good swimming skills is only one part of essential learning for being safer in water and the prevention of drowning.

Ensure pool drains and covers are in compliance with the Pool & Spa Safety Act, and that the drains are properly installed. You should have a life ring with a rope or safety hook nearby to help with rescues when necessary. Also, you should have a pool skimmer, a brush that attaches to a pole, and a pool vacuum to help keep the pool clean.
