An autobiography (from the Greek, $\hat{\iota}\hat{\alpha}\hat{\nu}\hat{\tau}\hat{o}\hat{s}$, $\hat{\iota}\hat{o}\hat{s}$, -autos self + $\hat{\beta}\hat{i}\hat{o}\hat{s}$ life + $\hat{\gamma}\hat{\rho}\hat{\alpha}\hat{\phi}\hat{\eta}\hat{i}\hat{n}$ to write) is a self-written account of the life of oneself. The word "autobiography" was first used deprecatingly by William Taylor in 1797 in the English periodical *The Monthly Review*, when he suggested the word as a hybrid, but condemned it as "pedantic".
